Advice for writing the report

- 1. The report is just as important as the program.
- 2. Write so that other people can understand your report.
- 3. Do not write to me (or yourself).
- 4. Be precise
- 5. Relate to the questions posed in the assignment
- 6. First, present the structure of the program and then those data structures and algorithms that are not obvious from the source code.
- 7. Use class skeletons and code fragments in order to make your documentation more concrete.
- 8. Use figures
- 9. Argue for your decisions.
- 10. Answer the questions of the assignment.
- 11. Explain how to run the program.
- 12. Describe how you have tested the program and show the results.





Advice for programming

- 1. Avoid using "magic numbers".
- 2. Keep the code as small, simple and readable as possible.
- 3. Use package visibility.
- 4. Don't suboptimize.
- 5. Consider alternatives before you start implementing a solution.
- 6. Start solving the general cases before solving the special cases.
